

Dear Minister,
every Saturday, the "Saturday Mothers" hold a peaceful vigil in Galatasaray Square in Istanbul, demanding investigation into the fate of their "disappeared" relatives. They are regularly attacked by the police, many participants are forcibly detained - although the Turkish Constitutional Court ruled that the ban of the vigils violates the right to peaceful assembly. Notwithstanding this, some "Saturday Mothers" and supporters are still facing trial for violating the Law on Assemblies.

I urge you to ensure that the Court's ruling is respected and that the "Saturday Mothers" can hold their vigils unhindered, as well as efforts are made to clarify the fate of the "disappeared", that perpetrators are brought to justice, and that the persecution of the "Saturday Mothers" is stopped.
