



## Free the Gezi Prisoners of Conscience

The imprisonment of the Gezi prisoners of conscience in 2022 is one of the most acute and visible examples of the ever worsening human rights situation in Türkiye.

From violently dispersed protests at Gezi Park in 2013 to a politically-motivated prosecution that led to the convictions of Osman Kavala and his co-defendants, this is a chronicle of chilling injustice.

The Gezi case is a politically-motivated prosecution and a betrayal of justice, which contravenes a binding decision of the European Court of Human Rights.
